ORDER

Whereas, the Ministry of Home Affairs vide Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I (A), dated 17.05.2020, has extended the lockdown till 31.05.2020, to contain the spread of COVID 19 and also had issued guidelines on lockdown measures which will be in force till 31.05.2020. Consequently, the Government of Karnataka vide Order No. RD 158 TNR 2020, Dated 18.05.2020 issued new guidelines on lockdown measures which will in force till 31.05.2020.

Whereas,The Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India, Vide Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I (A), dated 20.05.2020, has deleted 'domestic air travel of passengers' from the list of prohibited activities.Consequently, the Ministry of Civil Aviation, Govt. of India, vide Order. No. AV.29017/5/2020-DTand Order No. 01/2020, dated 21.05.2020, has permitted domestic civil flight operations from 25.05.2020.

In continuation of the Government Order No. RD 158 TNR 2020, dated 18.05.2020, and in exercise of the powers conferred under the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the undersigned, in his capacity of Chairman, State Executive Committee, hereby orders the following amendment in the guidelines on the lockdown measures, for strict implementation by all departments, District Deputy Commissioners, Superintendents of Police, BBMP, Police Commissioners and other Heads of Departments.

Amendment

In para 2 (i), 'domestic air travel of passengers' is deleted from the list of prohibited activities with effect from 25.05.2020.

The operation of the airports and air travel of passengers will be as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Civil Aviation, Govt. of India, and Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)/Guidelines issued from time to time by the Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of Karnataka.

Further, In light of commencement of domestic civil flight operations from 25.05.2020, **unhindered/unrestricted** movement of Air Passengers, with valid air ticket, and Airline Staff/Airport Staff/Crew members, with valid ID issued by their Company/Organization, **to and fro from** Airport is permitted even during curfew period, i.e., 7:pm to 7:00 am on all days and in addition from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm on Sundays as per the prevailing guidelines and SOPs issued by the Concerned Ministry of Government of India and State Government.
