Whereas, the proposal for revision of minimum rates of wages payable to the employees, employed in Shops and Establishments in the Union territory of Puducherry, was published as required under clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act 11 of 1948) in Notification issued by the Labour Department vide G.O. Ms. No. 27/AIL/Lab./G/2023, dated 14-08-2023 and published in the Official Gazette of Puducherry, No. 35, dated 29-08-2023, inviting objections and suggestions from all the persons likely to be affected thereby, within sixty (60) days from the date of publication of the said Notification in the Official Gazette of Puducherry;

And whereas, pursuant to the said Notification, objections/ suggestions received within the abovesaid stipulated time limit have been considered in depth;

And whereas, in pursuance of the proviso to sub-section (2) of section 5, the Minimum Wages Advisory Board constituted under section 7 of the said Act, has also been consulted with regard to the aforesaid revision of minimum rates of wages;

And whereas, after consideration of the grievance on the minimum rates of wages notified in the preliminary Notification and pursuant to the consensus arrived between the Employees and Employers Representative of the Advisory Board, the Minimum Wages Advisory Board unanimously resolved to recommend to increase the aforesaid revision of minimum rates of wages;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 3 read with sub-section (2) of section 5 and sub-section (1) of section 13 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act 11 of 1948) and in supersession of the Notification issued *vide* G.O. Ms. No. 09/AIL/Lab./G/2016, dated 22-08-2016 of the Labour Department, Government of Puducherry and published in Gazette of Puducherry, No. 36, dated 06-09-2016, the Lieutenant-Governor, Puducherry, is pleased to revise the minimum rates of wages payable in respect of the employees, employed in Shops and Establishments in the Union territory of Puducherry as specified in the Schedule hereunder:—

(ii) The Dearness Allowance shall be calculated on the 1st April of every year on the basis of the average of the indices for the preceding twelve (12) months *i.e.*, from January to December.

(iii) The first calculation shall thus be effective from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette of Government of Puducherry, based on the average of the Puducherry City Consumer Price Index points for the previous year.

NOTE

1. *Classification of Category*

- (a) **Highly Skilled.**— Highly Skilled employee is one who does the work which involves skill or competence of extraordinary degree and possesses supervisory ability.
- (b) **Skilled.**— Skilled employee is one who is capable of working independently and efficiently and turning out accurate working. He must be capable of reading and working on simple drawing circuits and process, if necessary.
- (c) **Semi-Skilled.**— Semi-skilled employee is one who has sufficient knowledge of the particular trade or above to do respective work and simple job with the help of simple tools and machines.
- (d) **Unskilled.**— Unskilled employee is one who possesses no special training and whose work involves the performance of the simple duties which require the exercise of little or no independent judgment or previous experience although a familiarity with the occupational environment is necessary. His work may thus require in articles or goods.

- (4) To arrive at monthly wages, the daily wages shall be multiplied by 30.
- (5) To arrive at daily wages, the weekly wages shall be divided by 6 and the monthly wages by 26.
- (6) Wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, the same shall be continued to be paid.
